The Recreational Navigation Commission of PIANC (RecCom) has re-opened the member nomination process for **RecCom Working Group 149** on "**Guidelines for Marina Design**". The content of this Working Group report has been divided in 5 parts, 3 of which have already been published. The Chairman of RecCom, with the strong support of ExCom, requested the **new call for members** to complete the remaining parts:

- Part 3: master plan development, layout of water areas, layout of landside facilities
- Part 5: disabled access, superyachts, operations and maintenance, environmental issues and sustainability, architecture and landscaping

We kindly ask you to inform RecCom by **30 April 2023** (copy to the General Secretariat [sabine.vandevelde@pianc.org](mailto:sabine.vandevelde@pianc.org)) about the name, qualification and e-mail address of the members appointed by your country/organisation. Please enclose a brief curriculum vitae of each member together with indication of relevant experience and/or letter of interest. We request that previous members re-apply, indicating interest in one or both parts. Each of these parts will have a new Chair. Candidates interested, can also put forward their candidacy to chair one of the parts.

An additional expert per country/organisation, being a young professional, can participate in the Working Group activities. **Further I would like to remind you that Working Group Members should either be Individual Member of PIANC, working for a Corporate Member or Platinum Partner, be an invited expert or a be a member of a Sister Organisation.**

We remind you that in accordance with PIANC rules, the costs incurred in taking part in Working Group activities are borne by the member countries/organizations.

We thank you beforehand for your collaboration.
